What is In-Room Dining?

In-Room Dining is the system used for our patients to receive their meals. **In-Room Dining** allows you to order what you would like and the ability to order it at any time during the day.



How does it work?

Once your doctor has determined your diet, you may select a meal from the menu. Please keep in mind that every item on the menu may not be allowed on the diet your doctor has put you on. A nutrition associate will guide you through the ordering process.

To place your order, use your room phone and dial "FOOD" (3663).

Your meal will be prepared just for you and delivered to your room within 45 minutes. You must place an order to receive the meal you would most enjoy. A family member, visitor or any Sturgis Hospital associate can help you place your order if needed. Your nurse may give you additional instructions about timing your meals around medications, tests or treatments.
